5. Well-developed interpersonal skills including excellent written and verbal communication, and computer and information technology skills. Competent in use of MS Windows and MS Office.
6. Understanding of and commitment to a feminist philosophy
7. Commitment to continuous quality improvement in all aspects of work
8. Ability to work as part of a small team and with minimal supervision
9. Willingness to work out of hours on occasion
10. A current Victorian manual driver's licence
